2015 MEMBERSHIP RENEWALS ARE DUE

Renew from October 1, 2014 through February 15, 2015 with NO reinstatement fee

If your application is not received and post dated by November 31, 2014, you will not be assured of access to the club after January 1, 2015 as it takes 30+ days for applications to be processed and checks to clear the bank!

Gate access will be turned off between January 1st and 2nd, 2015 unless your renewal was received by November 31, 2014.

It has always been a club rule that you must fill out a CURRENT year application. As of October 01, 2014 prior year applications will be returned. It takes a minimum of 30 days for checks to clear the bank and membership to be processed. If you mail in incomplete applications, old applications, or incorrect payments, your application will be returned which will delay the processing.

All <u>life members MUST</u> complete and sign a 2015 application to stay active. If a life member turns in an old application, it will be returned. If adding spouse, please include the \$25 payment. If you want access to the Indoor Archery/.22 Range, please include \$15 payment.

<u>New members</u> for 2015 require a sponsor. Sponsors are club members in good standing for at least 1 year continuing without lapse for 2015.

All **new members** must attend the membership meeting they are being voted in to receive their credentials. New members will not receive their credentials until they attend a meeting.

Gate Fob replacements can be obtained at membership meetings. Replacement cost is \$15.

NRA Memberships are available through the club web site. There is a NRA icon on the front page of the site. Clicking on the icon will take you directly to the NRA membership website. All NRA memberships received though the club will give us credit as an NRA sponsor.

1ST VP REPORT/CHIEF RANGE OFFICER

We are getting close to the hunting season and the 50/100 yard ranges will be used for sighting in rifles. Please make sure to assign a range officer when there is more than one shooter on the range and sign in when using any of the ranges. The club rule of not stapling your targets to the range frames also includes the 100 yards. Please make sure your targets are set between the frames. Stapling/shooting into the frames is a rule violation.

Please remember that all range maintenance is being done by volunteers. Respect their work and time by making sure to pick up your spent casings and trash. Don't forget to remove your targets when you are done shooting.

The roof over the 15-yard range was completed recently and cross beams have been shot already. Please make sure you only do standing shooting on the 7- and 15-yard ranges. These ranges were designed for standing only and not to be used in a sitting position. There should be no reason for the roof cross beams to be hit if you are shooting properly and safely.

I want to thank all the volunteers who came out this year and helped complete the ranges. There will be cleaning parties set up through out 2015 by Russ Brooks. If you are on the volunteer list you may be called and asked to help with future projects.

Please respect the Club Security Officers when approached on the ranges. You will not be approached if you are following club rules and are displaying club ID.

YOUTH .22 PROGRAM

The youth .22 program has begun their fall season. We teach fundamentals of shooting, rifle and range safety, and positions for competition. We practice Tuesday evenings from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm and Saturday mornings from 10:00 am to 12:00 pm. When our students are ready, we travel to other ranges in PA in order to compete. Students are also able to earn NRA Marksmanship Qualification rockers to show their progress. These patches give the students tangible evidence of their continuing improvement.

We offer an NRA basic rifle class for youth 8 to 20 years old. It is scheduled for January and February 2015, but we do not have specific dates set as of yet. The class is free to all youth. We have club rifles that can be used, but you will need to supply your own .22 ammo. We are limiting the class to 12 students. NRA BASIC PISTOL CLASS Saturday August 15, 2015 8:00 to 6:30 pm

Mechanicsburg Sportsmen will be holding at least one Basic Pistol Class in 2015. It will be an 8-hour co-ed course with 12 seats available. The club will supply .22 semi-auto 22/45 Ruger pistols with .22 ammo if you do not have your own firearm. You may bring your own firearm but if you do you will be asked to supply your own 50 + rounds of ammo. We ask that barrel lengths be 4" or longer. YOUTH ARCHERY NEWS

Rider Memorial Nursery after Clarence passed away. Clarence started the nursery over 30 years ago. The names on the plaque are Charley Diener who did all the paperwork for Clarence. Roger Jumper and Arthur Eakin who were co-managers for many years and were instrumental in the rebuild of the nursery to the excellent facility we have now. Many thanks to them and all the others over the years.

4-H SHOOTING SPORTS

4-H is a community of young people across America who learn leadership, citizenship, and life skills. The focus of all 4-H programs is the development of youth as individuals and as responsible and productive citizens. Mechanicsburg's 4-H Shooting Sports Program stands out as an example. Youth learn marksmanship, the safe and responsible use of firearms, record-keeping and much more. The activities of the program and the support of NRA-Certified adult leaders provide young people with opportunities to develop life skills, self-worth, responsibility, and ethics.

The program offers junior shooters an opportunity to be engaged in positive youth development experiences and recognized for marksmanship performance. Juniors learn to shoot air rifle, air pistol, .22 rifle, shotgun, and muzzle loaders. The Shooting Sports Program develops skills for life and activities for a lifetime.

We just finished the 2013-2014 program with the muzzle loading rifle project. In all, twelve youth were involved in different projects ranging from air rifle to shotgun. RELOADING CLASS -- RIFLE & PISTOL CARTRIDGES

For the price of two boxes of ammo, you can gain the lifetime skill of ammunition reloading. Attend the NRA Basic Reloading Course for Metallic Cartridges held at MSA on Saturday, February 21, 2015 from 9:00 am to 6:00 pm. A team of NRA Certified Firearms Instructors will provide this 8-hour course which covers the basic knowledge, skills, and attitudes necessary to safely reload metallic cartridges for your rifle or handgun. The \$50 fee covers the NRA Reloading textbook, NRA Safety Rules pamphlet, use of all reloading equipment and supplies, as well as a full day's training.

Topics include introduction to reloading and reloading safety, using the reloading manual and reloading data, selecting and setting up reloading equipment, requirements for a basic reloading bench, and a hands-on opportunity to practice reloading pistol and rifle cartridges.

An NRA Certificate of Completion will be awarded for successfully completing the course. This is not an advanced reloading course; it is intended for beginning reloaders. Pre-registration is required as class size is limited—for more information or to register for the class, contact Ron Keslar, 717-432-9039, rjkeslar@aol.com.
